Torbay-based theatre company announces auditions for drama about survivors of the Titanic

Summary

A Brixham-based non-profit theatre company specialising in historical drama, announces open auditions for new stage production about the survivors of the Titanic who came to Plymouth

Content

The South Devon Players Theatre Company, an awardwinning theatre company from Brixham, launch their ninth year of productions, with a new drama telling the story of survivors from the Titanic, who returned to Plymouth in 1912. As with all South Devon Players productions, auditions are open to anyone interested in becoming involved with a dynamic theatre group that specialises in newly written historical dramas performed to a professional standard.

Auditions will take place on Sunday February 8th, 2015 at the Chestnut Community Centre (Poplar Close, Brixham) from 1 – 4pm, and anyone interested in joining us, regardless of experience, is invited to attend.

Rehearsals with the Players, take place on Wednesday evenings and Sunday afternoons, with the shows usually running from a Friday – Sunday. (in the case of Survivors of the Titanic, this is aimed to take place in June.) The theatre shows mainly take place in Torbay at the Palace Theatre as our main venue, and then on Sundays at the St Matthias Church in Torquay for the Sunrise Rotary Club as our traditional charity performance.

Behind the scenes we are also working on a film series of Les Miserables, for global internet broadcast, and we also provide a careers service, providing opportunities, for those who want to aim for a theatre or film based career, in the form of networking, castings (almost like an informal agency) and jobs, for anything ranging from student films through to the West End and Hollywood features, when they need people in the Southwest. Members and volunteers become eligible for the careers service once one full show run with us, or with another local production with directors whom we know, is completed, so that everyone is known to be reliable and serious, with some experience.

The South Devon Players is a lively, outgoing and friendly team which welcomes serious and friendly performers of all levels of experience.

This exciting new project also demonstrated that “amateur” theatre / drama groups do not need to be “amateur” in their approach to projects, and that ordinary people can achieve impressive projects.

The South Devon Players Theatre Company are members of both the National Operatic and Dramatic Association (NODA) and of the Brixham Chamber of Commerce.
